

2024 MAPLE GROVE RACEWAY CAMPING RULES AND REGULATIONS

TRACKSIDE TERRACE & RV COURT

Thank you for being our guest at Maple Grove Raceway. The following information has been created to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all guests in attendance. All guests are required to take responsibility for their actions and behaviors to ensure that experience.

Maple Grove Raceway asks that you read through the following rules and regulations very carefully. The owner of the camping space will be asked to sign their name at the bottom of the document. This signature shows Maple Grove Raceway that the camping site owner has read through, acknowledges and agrees to all of the items listed in this agreement. It is the responsibility of the camping site owner to share these rules with all members of their party.

If any of the rules listed in this agreement are unclear, please reach out to Sarah Gingrich (sarah@mgraceway.com) or (610-856-9200), prior to signing.

ARRIVAL PROCEDURE & TIMES

TRACKSIDE TERRACE

- **Check-in Times:**
 - Thursday, September 12th: 6am-6pm
 - Friday, September 13th: 6am-8pm
 - Saturday, September 14th: 6am-6pm
 - No campers are allowed on any Maple Grove Raceway property prior to Thursday, Sept. 12th.
- **Check-out Times:**
 - Sunday, September 15th: After event
 - Monday, September 16th: By 10am
- **Arrival Location During Check-in Times:**
 - You will turn in to the Main Entrance (Gate 4). Please have your tickets either printed out or pulled up on your phone to be scanned. Once your tickets are scanned, you will be given a wristband. It must be worn for the entire duration of your stay.
 - The Parking Pass Sticker will be attached to the vehicle you arrive in, which is either pulling the camper or the actual camper. The Parking Pass Vehicle is the vehicle or camper that can enter and exit the gate, as well as park in the camping space. The sticker **MUST** remain on the vehicle for the entire duration of the stay. If a sticker is removed, it will not be replaced.
 - Any other vehicle that enters will need to pay the addition Parking Pass fee and will be parked in the overflow parking. No exceptions.
 - If you are renting a camper from a third-party company, please notify Sarah Gingrich (sarah@mgraceway.com) or (610-856-9200), prior to September 1, 2024.

- **Arrival Location After Check-in Times:**

- You will turn in to the Main Entrance (Gate 4). You will park in the field on the left until the next morning. The next morning you follow the procedure of arriving during check-in times. If you are unsure of this location on the included map, please call or email Sarah.
- Do NOT enter the gates or park in your space until being escorted by a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member during gate times. You will be asked to move and will possibly lose your space.
- This includes if you have had the same space for years! You must check-in prior to being escorted to your space.

- **Camping Space Relocating:**

- RVs and trailers are not permitted to relocate once a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member has parked you into your space. If guests move their RV or trailer from their initially assigned space, Maple Grove Raceway Management is not responsible for holding that space for renewals. This is also extremely important, in the event of an emergency medical professionals can attend to the situation faster.
 - You will be assigned a camping space, based off all information provided during booking. So, it is crucial that all vehicle and camper lengths are accurate. If any lengths change after booking, please notify Sarah immediately, so other accommodations can be made prior to arrival.

RV COURT

- **Check-in Times:**

- Thursday, September 12th: 6am-6pm
- Friday, September 13th: 6am-8pm
- Saturday, September 14th: 6am-6pm
- No campers are allowed on any Maple Grove Raceway property prior to Thursday, Sept. 12th.

- **Check-out Times:**

- Sunday, September 15th: After event
- Monday, September 16th: By 10am

- **Arrival Location During Check-in Times:**

- You will turn in to the Main Entrance (Gate 4). Please have your tickets either printed out or pulled up on your phone to be scanned. Once your tickets are scanned, you will be given a wristband. It must be worn for the entire duration of your stay.
- The Parking Pass Sticker will be attached to the vehicle you arrive in, which is either pulling the camper or the actual camper. The Parking Pass Vehicle is the vehicle or camper that can enter and exit the gate, as well as park in the camping space. The sticker **MUST** remain on the vehicle for the entire duration of the stay. If a sticker is removed, it will not be replaced.
- Any other vehicle that enters will need to pay the addition Parking Pass fee and will be parked in the overflow parking. No exceptions.
- If you are renting a camper from a third-party company, please notify Sarah Gingrich (sarah@mgraceway.com) or (610-856-9200), prior to September 1, 2024.

- **Arrival Location After Check-in Times:**

- You will turn in to the Main Entrance also referred to Gate 4. You will park in the field on the left until the next morning. If you are unsure of this location on the included map, please call or email Sarah.
- **Do NOT** enter the gates or park in your space until being escorted by a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member during gate times. You will be asked to move and will possibly lose your space.

- **Camping Space Relocating:**

- RVs and trailers are not permitted to relocate once a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member has parked you into your space. If guests move their RV or trailer from their initially assigned space, Maple Grove Raceway Management is not responsible for holding that space for renewals. This is also extremely important, in the event of an emergency medical professionals can attend to the situation faster.
 - You will be assigned a camping space, based off all information provided during booking. So, it is crucial that all vehicle and camper lengths are accurate. If any lengths change after booking, please notify Sarah immediately, so other accommodations can be made prior to arrival.

Golf Carts or Auxiliary Vehicles:

*I understand that golf carts, ATVs, scooters, mini bikes, etc. are **NOT PERMITTED** in any area of the raceway, camping areas or roads. I also acknowledge that I will not bring any of these items to the event. And if I do bring the item(s), my keys will be given to MGR Management upon arrival and until the end of the event. If I do not follow these guidelines, I will be asked to leave without any refund of camping space or tickets. I understand that this policy goes for all members of my party. If I require mobility accommodations, I am able to use a mobility scooter, motorized wheelchair or manual wheelchair. If none of these options are available, please reach out to Sarah before signing the agreement.*

In the Event of an Emergency

- If you or anyone in your party has issues or problems during your stay, feel free to visit the Event Services building inside Main Entrance (Gate 4).
- In an event of an emergency, please call 911 and provide your site number to the dispatcher.

All camping ticket holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests or any other people they allow to use their seats/ camping area. Event patrons and/ or guests who violate these provisions will be subject to ejection without refund, and risk potential loss of ticket privileges for future shows. Camping ticket holders are required to refrain from the following:

- Behavior that is unruly, disruptive or illegal in nature.
- Intoxication or other signs of impairment that results in offensive and/or irresponsible behavior.
- Foul or abusive language or obscene gestures.
- Interference with the event.
- Failure to follow instructions of track personnel or law enforcement.
- Verbal or physical harassment of others including all fans, participants, officials and staff.
- Smoking in the grandstands or midway.
- Theft or vandalism.

- Engaging in any of the above code violations in any areas that are owned or operated by Maple Grove Raceway or its affiliates.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- You must not park yourself, please either wait in line during check-in times or park in the designated area after gate times. If you park yourself (no matter how many years, you have had the same site) you will be asked to move or if any issues arise with your space, our staff is unable to provide assistance.
- Scooters, golf carts, or ATV units are NOT permitted in any area of the Raceway including in Parkside camping, refer to the "Golf Cart & Auxiliary Vehicle" Section.
- Campfires **MUST** be above ground in fire rings, no burning of ground. Campers must provide their own above ground fire ring.
- The owner of the camping site will be held responsible for all members of his or her party.
- Place trash at end of your space near the road each night to be picked up.
- Campers are expected to leave your site as clean as you found it.
- All generators must be properly vented away from other campers.
- Please be respectful of quiet times (11pm-6am) in regards to generators, music and noise.
- Firearms are NOT permitted on grounds.
- Be respectful of other campers' privacy during an emergency.
- Tents are NOT permitted in with RV Camping! This is for the safety of all guests. If a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member finds a tent camper in the RV camping area, they will be asked to move immediately.
- Campers are responsible for bringing any tables or chairs for their site. Picnic tables are not provided or available.
- Dogs must remain on a leash at all times, even in the camping space!
- Pet owners must have a Pet Registration Form completed and on file before arrival.
- Guests must clean up after pets.
- Be sure to lock your vehicles and campers at all times, Maple Grove Raceway is not responsible for any stolen items.
- In the event of a rainout, no credit is offered on these camping sites as these are sold as camping packages for the weekend.
- The Maple Grove Raceway Team may exercise his or her discretion in the enforcement and application of these rules listed in the agreement.
- There are no refunds for the camping site or tickets after purchase.
- In the case of a rainout, no credit is offered on tickets as these spots are sold as a camping package for the weekend of the event.
