To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all attendees, we have outlined important rules and regulations that all guests must follow. It is each guest's responsibility to adhere to these guidelines and conduct themselves appropriately to maintain a positive atmosphere.

Please review the following rules and regulations carefully. The owner of each camping space must sign at the bottom of this document, acknowledging that they have read, understood, and agreed to the terms outlined. Additionally, it is the responsibility of the camping site owner to share these rules with all members of their party. Arrival Procedure & Times

TRACKSIDE TERRACE & RV COURT

- **Check-in Times:**

- Thursday, September 11th: 6am-6pm
- Friday, September 12th: 6am-8pm
- Saturday, September 13th: 6am-6pm
- No campers are allowed on any Maple Grove Raceway property prior to Thursday, Sept. 11th.

- **Check-out Times:**

- Sunday, September 14th: After event
- Monday, September 15th: By 10am

Arrival Location During Check-in Times

- **Entrance & Ticketing:** Upon arrival, please enter through the **Main Entrance (Gate 4)**. Have your tickets **either printed or ready on your phone** for scanning. Once scanned, you will receive a wristband, which **must be worn for the entire duration of your stay**.
- **Parking Pass Sticker:** A sticker will be attached to the vehicle you arrive in—either the one pulling your camper or the camper itself. This designated vehicle will be allowed to enter and exit the gate and must remain parked in your assigned camping space. The sticker must remain on the vehicle for the entire duration of your stay and will not be replaced if removed.
- **Additional Vehicles:** Any additional vehicle entering the premises must pay an additional Parking Pass fee and will be directed to overflow parking. **No exceptions.**
- **Third-Party Camper Rentals:** If you are renting a camper from a third-party company, you must notify Sarah at sarah@mgraceway.com or (610) 856-9200 before **September 1, 2025**.

Arrival Location After Check-in Times

- **Late Arrivals:** If you arrive after check-in hours, please enter through **Main Entrance (Gate 4)** and park in the designated **field on the left** until the following morning. At that time, you must follow the standard check-in procedures. If you need assistance locating this area on the provided map, please contact **Sarah** via **email or phone**.
- **Do Not Enter Without Escort:** You **must not** enter the gates or park in your assigned camping space until escorted by a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member during official gate

hours. Unauthorized parking may result in you being asked to move and could lead to the loss of your space.

- **No Exceptions for Returning Guests:** Even if you have had the same camping space for years, **you must check in and be escorted to your space upon arrival.**

Camping Space Relocating

- **No Unauthorized Relocation:** Once a Maple Grove Raceway Team Member has parked your RV or trailer in its assigned space, **you are not permitted to move it.** If you relocate without approval, Maple Grove Raceway Management is not responsible for reserving your space for future renewals. Additionally, maintaining assigned locations is crucial for emergency access.
- **Accurate Vehicle & Camper Lengths:** Your assigned camping space is based on the information provided at the time of booking. If the length of your vehicle or camper changes after booking, please notify Sarah immediately so appropriate accommodations can be made before your arrival.

Golf Carts & Auxiliary Vehicles

*I understand that **golf carts, ATVs, scooters, mini bikes, and similar vehicles are NOT PERMITTED** in any area of the raceway, camping grounds, or roadways. I acknowledge that **I will not bring any of these items to the event.** If I do bring a prohibited vehicle, my keys will be collected by Maple Grove Raceway Management upon arrival and held until the end of the event. Failure to comply with this policy will result in **immediate removal from the premises without a refund for camping space or tickets.** This policy applies to **all members of my party.***

For guests requiring mobility accommodations, **mobility scooters, motorized wheelchairs, and manual wheelchairs are permitted.** If none of these options are available, please contact **Sarah before signing the agreement** to discuss alternative arrangements.

In the Event of an Emergency

- If you or a member of your party experiences **any issues during your stay**, please visit the **Event Services building** located inside **Main Entrance (Gate 4).**
- In case of an **emergency**, call **911 immediately** and provide your **camping site number** to the dispatcher.

Code of Conduct

All camping ticket holders are **responsible for their conduct** as well as the behavior of their guests or anyone they allow to use their camping area. Violations of these policies may result in **ejection without a refund** and possible loss of ticket privileges for future events.

Prohibited behavior includes, but is not limited to:

- Unruly, disruptive, or illegal behavior. Use of **foul or abusive language** or **obscene gestures**
- Intoxication or impairment leading to offensive and/or irresponsible actions.
- Interfering with the event in any manner.
- Failure to follow **instructions from track personnel or law enforcement.**
- **Verbal or physical harassment** of other guests, fans, participants, officials, or staff.
- **Smoking in prohibited areas**, including the grandstands and midway.
- **Theft or vandalism.**

Engaging in any of the above violations **anywhere on Maple Grove Raceway property.**

By attending, you agree to abide by these rules to ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all guests.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- **Do Not Park Yourself:** You must either **wait in line** during check-in times or park in the **designated area** after gate hours. **Self-parking is not allowed**—even if you have had the same site for years. If you park yourself, you will be asked to move, and our staff will not be able to assist with any issues that may arise.
- **No Scooters, Golf Carts, or ATVs:** These vehicles **are not permitted** anywhere on the Raceway grounds, including **Parkside camping**. Refer to the "**Golf Cart & Auxiliary Vehicle**" section for details.
- **Campfires:** Fires must be contained in **above-ground fire rings**—burning directly on the ground is **not permitted**. Campers must provide their own fire ring.
- **Site Owner Responsibility:** The registered **owner of the camping site is responsible** for all members of their party.
- **Trash Disposal:** Place **trash at the end of your space** near the road **each night** for pickup.
- **Leave No Trace:** Campers are expected to leave their site **as clean as they found it**.
- **Generator Safety:** All generators must be **properly vented away** from neighboring campers.
- **Quiet Hours: 11:00 PM - 6:00 AM** – Please be respectful regarding **generator use, music, and noise** during these hours.
- **No Firearms:** Firearms **are not permitted** on Raceway grounds.
- **Respect Privacy in Emergencies:** Please be mindful of other campers' privacy and space during an emergency.
- **No Tents in RV Camping: Tents are not permitted** in RV camping areas for **safety reasons**. If a tent is in an RV site, the camper will be asked to relocate immediately.
- **Picnic tables are not provided**—campers must bring their own tables and chairs.
- **Pet Policies:**
 - Dogs must remain **on a leash at all times**, even within the camping space.
 - A **Pet Registration Form** must be completed and on file **before arrival**.
 - Owners **must clean up after their pets**.
- **Security & Personal Belongings:** Be sure to lock your vehicles and campers at all times. Maple Grove Raceway is not responsible for stolen items.
- **Rainout Policy:**
 - **No credits or refunds** are issued for camping sites, as they are sold as part of a **weekend camping package**.
 - **NHRA** has the final say on event status, in accordance with the "**National Event Rain Check Policy**" available at NHRA.com.
- **No Refunds:** All camping site and ticket sales **are final—no refunds will be issued**.
- **Enforcement of Rules:** The **Maple Grove Raceway Team** reserves the right to enforce and apply these rules at their discretion.
